

Nappy Change Procedure

Changing a nappy without spreading germs

Preparation

- 1. Wash your hands
- 2. Place paper on the change table
- 3. Put disposable gloves on both hands
- 4. Assist child onto the change table



Changing

- 5. Remove the child's nappy and put any disposable nappy in nappy disposal bin. Place any soiled clothes (including any cloth nappy) in a plastic bag.
- 6. Clean the child's nappy area
- 7. Remove the paper and put it in a hands-free lidded bin.
- 8. Remove your gloves and put them in hands free-lidded bin
- 9. Apply a clean set of disposable gloves (optional)
- 10. Place a clean nappy on the child
- 11. Dress the child
- 12. Assist child to safely exit the change table
- 13. Wash your hands and the child's hands.



Cleaning

- 14. After each nappy change, clean the change table with disinfectant and paper towel.
- 15. Wash your hands.
