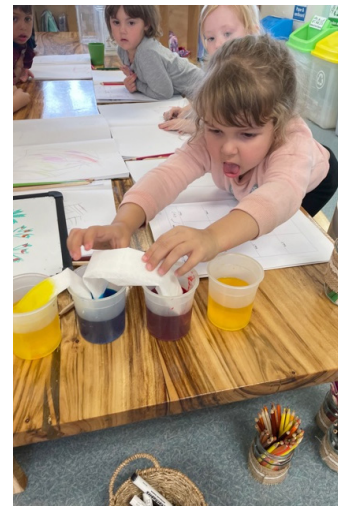

Colour Mixing

This term the Burbi Group has had a continuous interest in colour mixing. Over the past 2 weeks educators have extended this interest by offering various learning experiences focused on the primary colours and how they can mix together to make secondary colours. The children have engaged in experiments and art experiences where they have been able to hypothesise what colours they think will be made when the primary colours are mixed together and have tested their theories in a variety of ways. Educators will continue to foster this learning by providing the children with experiences looking at the colour wheel and what makes colours “warm” and “cool”.

Frogs Ribbit, Ribbit... Our learning project on Frogs Vs Toads has continued this term. The children have been learning about the Lifecycle of a frog/toad and using their thinking and planning floor books to record their learning. Educators have been extremely impressed with each child's growth in their early literacy writing and representations.

The children have explicitly looked at the differences between frogs and toads and what characteristics each species identifies with. They have represented these characteristics through creative arts such as drawing, painting and sculpture. The children's learning will be present in our learning space and we invite our families to come in and take a look at what they have been learning at preschool.
