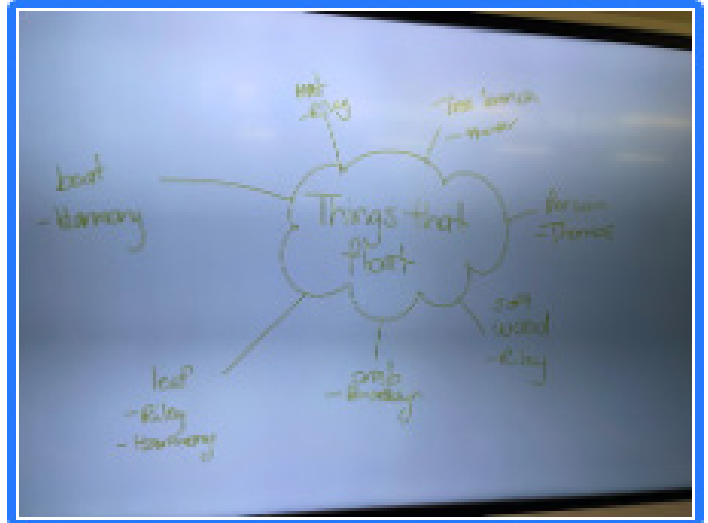
Growing and Learning

Gardening and growing things has been an ongoing interest for our Gurrahman Jarjums this year. To continue to foster this interest and extend on it through engaging experiences, educators provided children with resources to make grass heads. The children used stockings, soil, plastic cups, water and grass seeds to create their grass heads. We then decorated them with googly eyes, pom poms and cardboard for clothing. Over the past week the children have been watering their grass heads and checking each day to see how long they have grown. Some children were even able to give their grass heads a haircut as the seeds were growing so fast. This is a great experience to explore relationships between other living things where the children can observe, notice and respond to change.



Sinking and Floating

This term our Burbi Jarjums have been exploring the concept of sinking and floating. We have been researching what makes things float and sink and why. Through our research we have discovered that every object or “thing” is made up of particles. In some objects, particles are compact and close together, and in others they are far apart. This determines whether an object will sink or float. The children put their research into action by using resources from preschool to test their theories on floating and sinking. The children hypothesised about what objects they thought would sink and which ones would float. They recorded their ideas in their thinking and planning floor books. After experimenting with the objects, we reflected on the experience and discussed their predictions and why they were correct or incorrect.

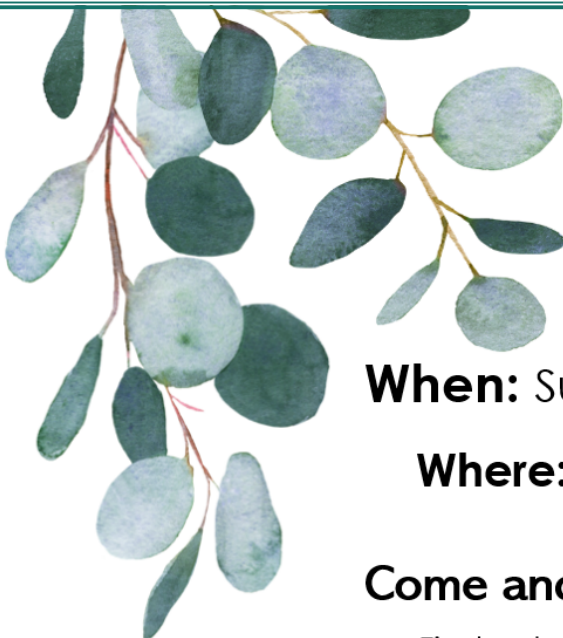


Preschool 2022
