
# Maths through play

Our core business is play!!! As educators, we are guided by the children's interests and extend on these through intentional teaching opportunities. Maths is everywhere and is constantly explored through play-based learning experiences. Here is an example of how a simple maths concept can be a focus of a spontaneous learning experience. Faviola was playing at the playdough table and was using her fine motor skills to mould the playdough into small balls, and lines. Independently, Faviola organised the lines and balls into an 'AB pattern', ball, line, ball, line etc. Mrs Clark then fostered this interest by guiding and questioning Faviola to extend her thinking and learning about how pattern systems work.


