'Everyday' and 'Sometimes' foods

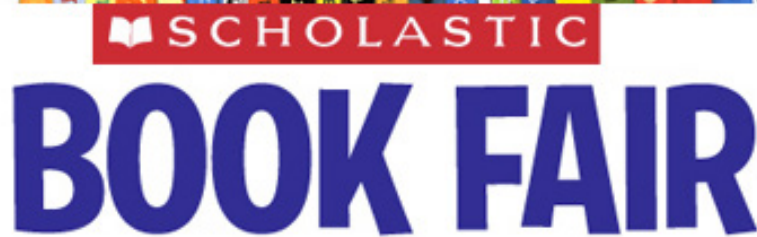

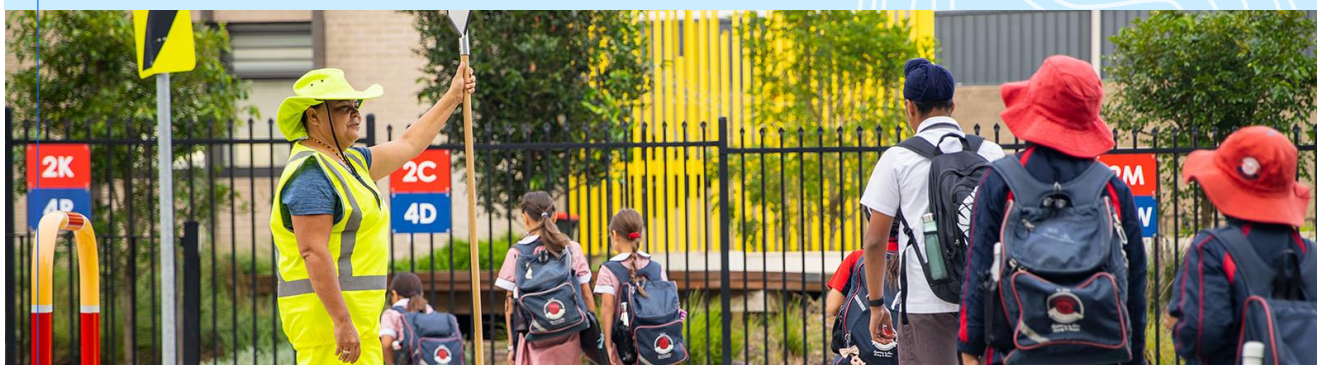


Marble Painting
