
# Feeling the Feels: Exploring Our Zones!

Through stories, discussions, and play, the children are learning to recognise how they're feeling and explore helpful strategies to regulate those emotions. It's been inspiring to see children using zone language in their play and even teaching their peers what they've learned! Using this language at home is a great way to support consistency and help children apply their emotional awareness across different settings.
