This course is being run at the Lismore District Office and will complement the very successful SisterSpeak program Auntie Sue has been running.

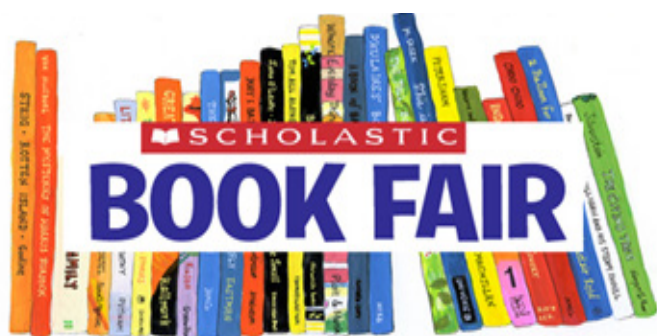

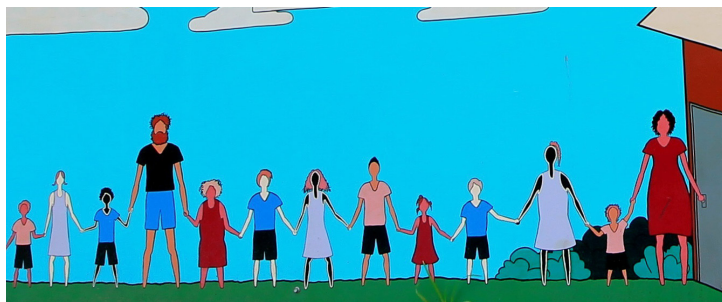
