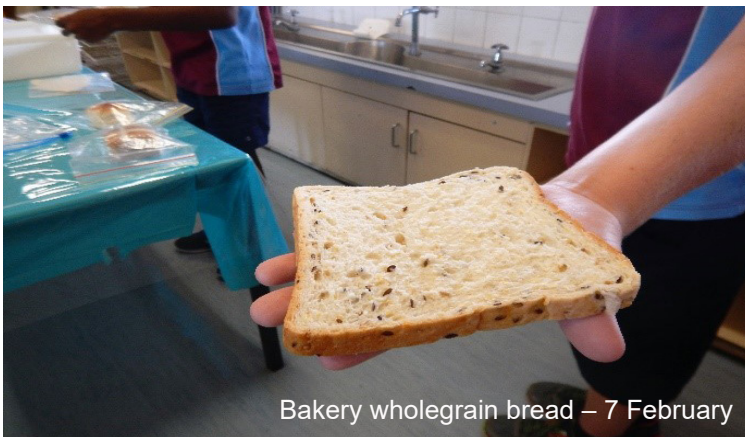

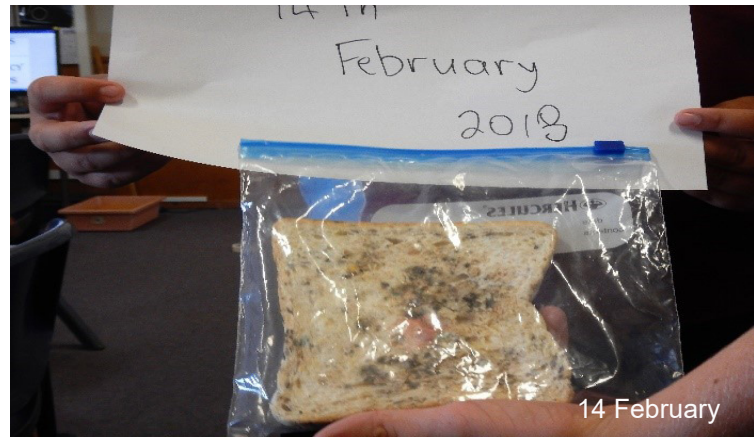

Bakery wholegrain bread – 7 February

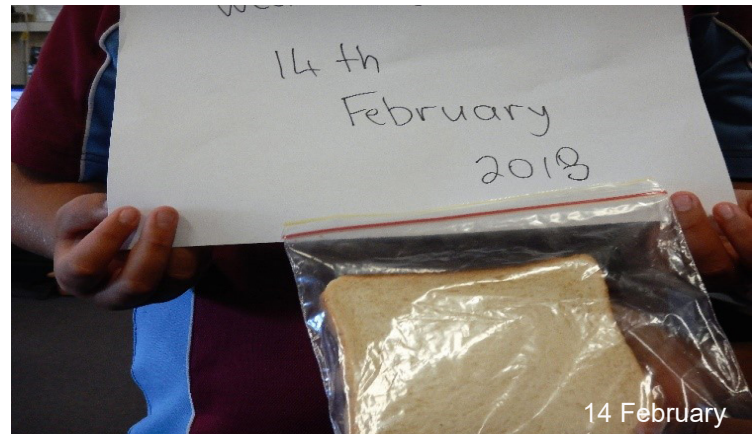

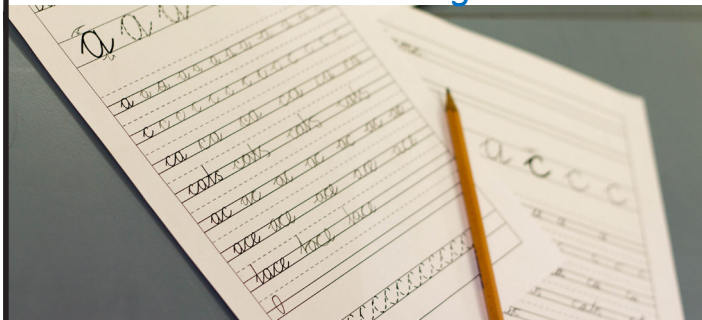


## P&C News

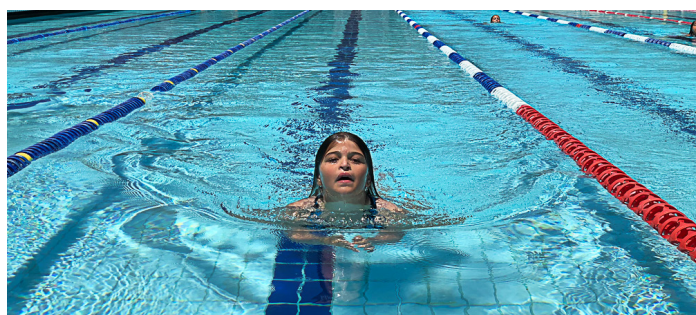


## Expression of interest forms
