## Healthy teeth and happy children

Northern NSW Local Health District, Oral Health Services will be visiting Casino West in Term 2. Kindergarten and Year 2 students will participate in the program. There are both clinical and educational components. If follow up treatment is required, it will be offered in a public dental clinic.

Baby teeth are very important. Decay and early extractions influence the child's nutrition, growth, social behaviour, tooth positioning, sleep pattern and general well-being.

Regular dental check-ups can prevent minor problems becoming major ones, preventing unnecessary pain and distress.

This program is a way to help maintain healthy oral hygiene habits for children in life, and improve regular access to dental care close to home.
