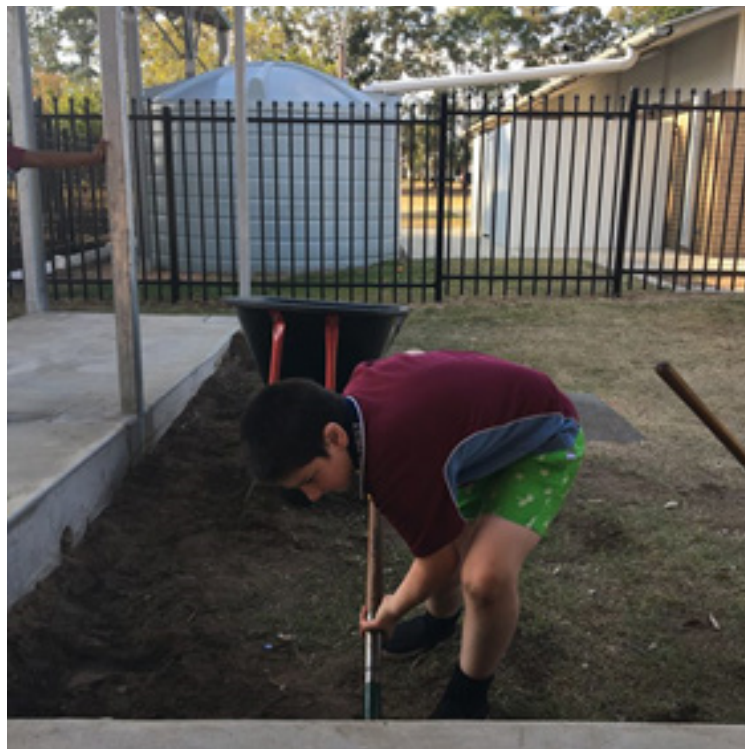

Hope to see you around the school.

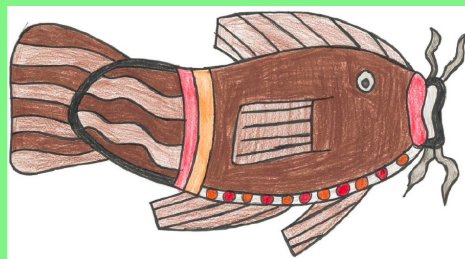

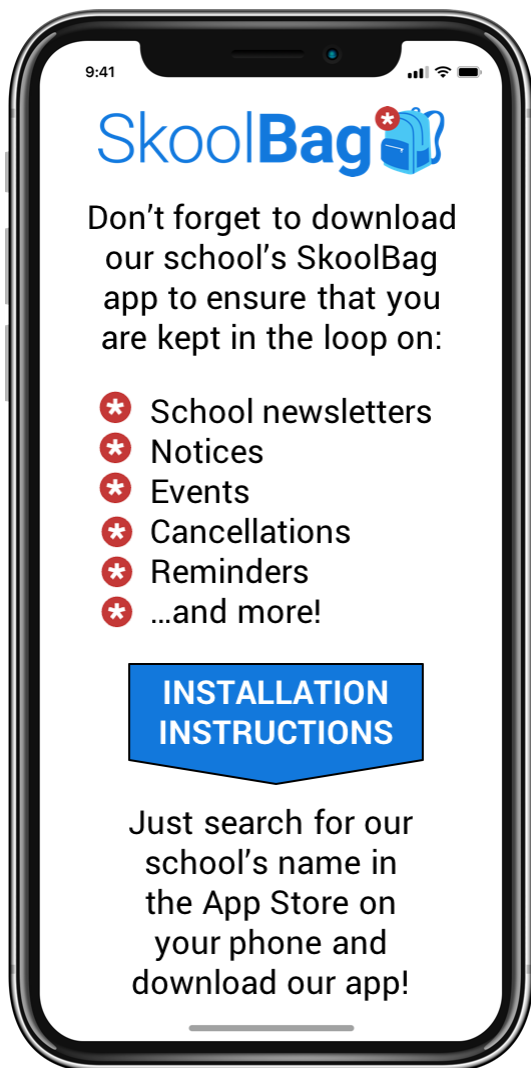
