Please be aware that students who come late will need to provide the school with a note or parents will have to let the office staff know to explain the delay as we have to now enter this on a live website. If your

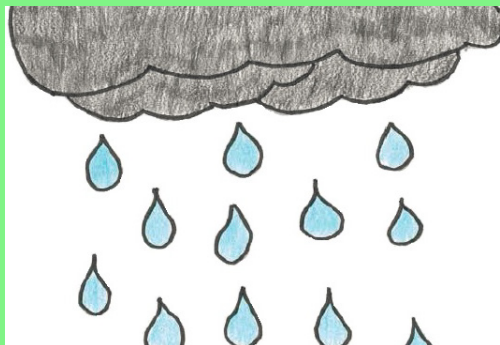

On the day we will have some masks available to wear if you have concerns about any type of reaction.

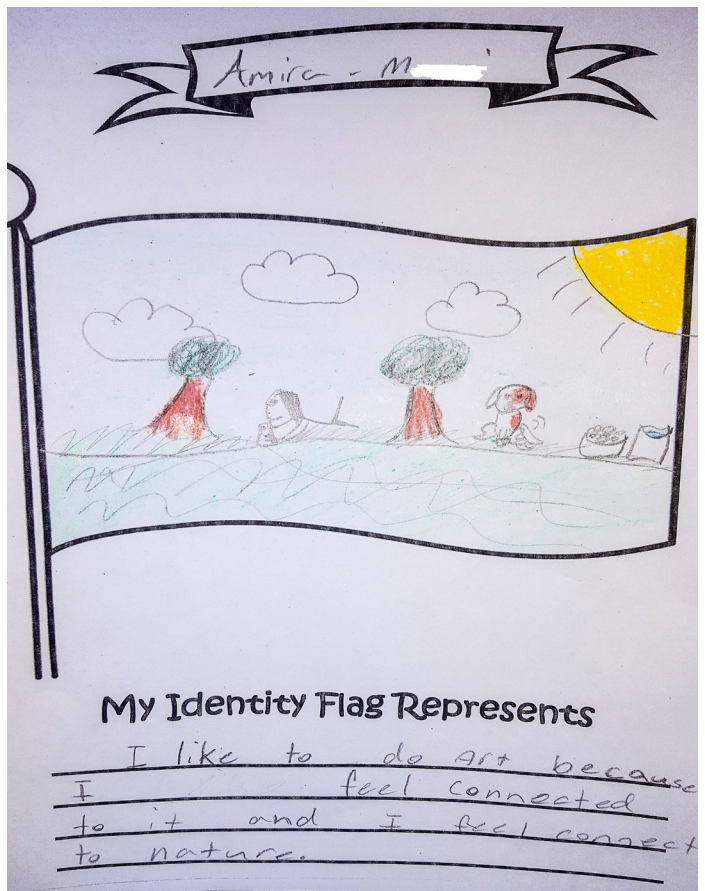
The colour fun run will be a whole load of fun for all involved and participants will run only a short distance.
