We are really engaged with our new interactive whiteboard and use it for many learning activities. Mrs Susanne Schneider.

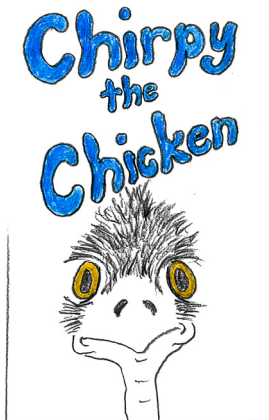
It's the time of year when I would like to thank all of our helpers and people who have volunteered in the school.

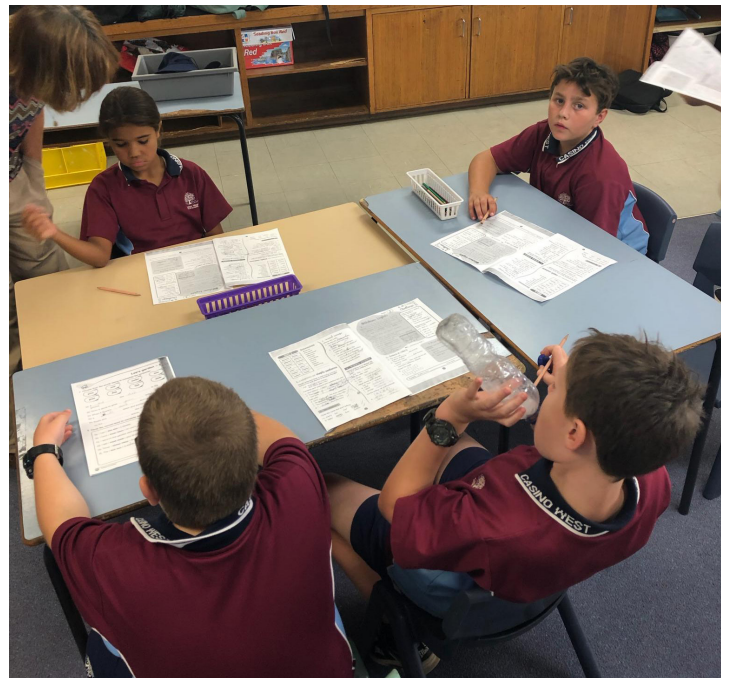

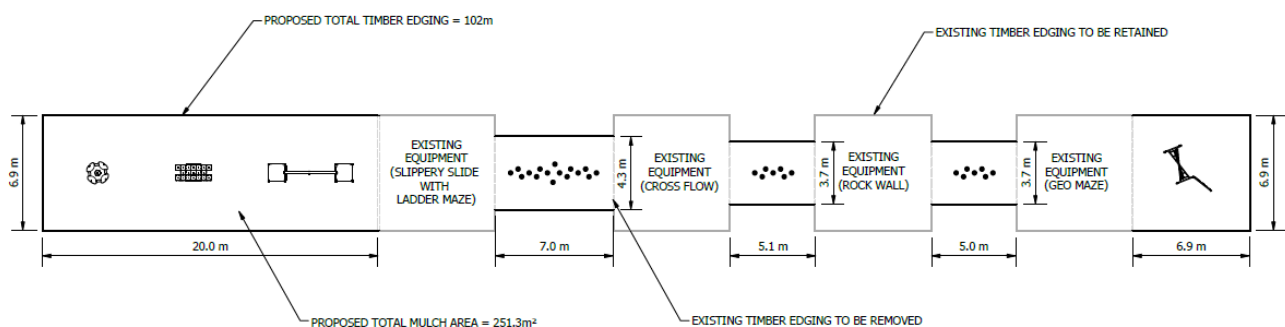

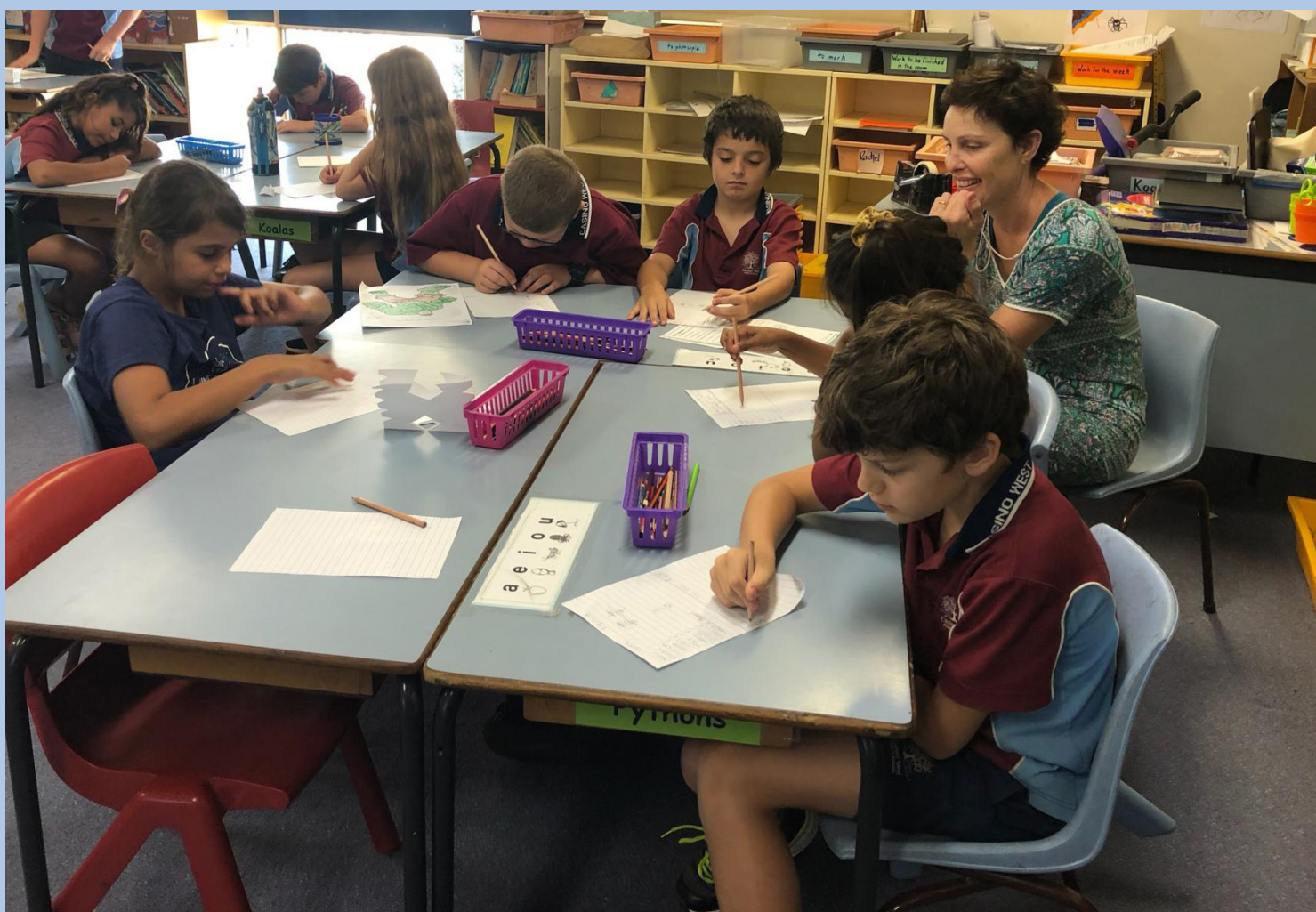
