Jan's high expectations of both students and staff (including herself) lived up to our current school motto of Dream, Believe and Achieve.

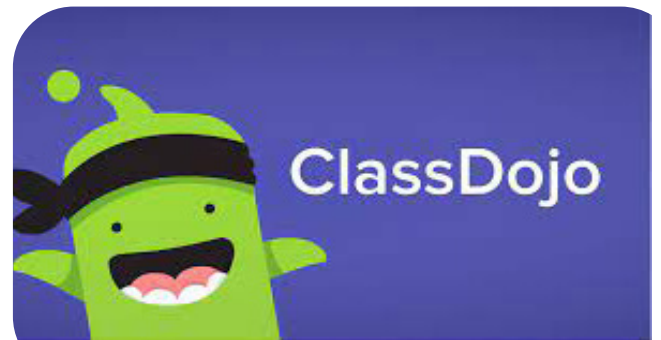
Jan's presence in our school will be sadly missed and she leaves behind a legacy that all of us would strive to achieve.

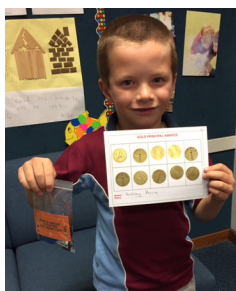
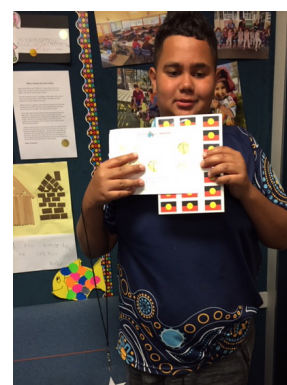
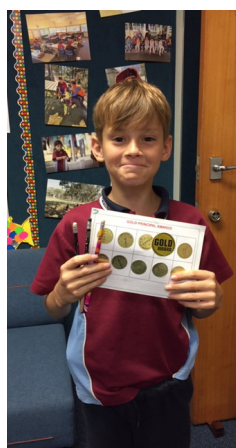
FACT Children are small, harder to see, behave unpredictably and are extremely vulnerable. They need **YOU** to take extra care when driving and parking around school zones.
