


















From the library desk





Check-in assessment for Years 3, 4 and 5

Dear Parents and Carers,

Students in Years 3, 4 and 5 will participate in a reading and numeracy Check-in assessment.

The Check-in assessment is a NSW Department of Education online reading and numeracy assessment available to support schools to assess and monitor student learning.

The Check-in assessments can supplement existing school practices to identify how students are performing in literacy and numeracy and to help teachers tailor their teaching more specifically to student needs.

- The assessment for Reading and Numeracy is scheduled for our;
 - Year 3 students on Tuesday 25th October, 2022 (Term 4 Week 3)
 - Year 4 students on Tuesday 1st November, 2022 (Term 4 Week 4)
 - Year 5 students on Tuesday 18th October, 2022 (Term 4 Week 2)

Students will be completing the assessments on line during the morning session at school.
