3/4S and 3/4N will finally get to go on their excursion to Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary on Wed 9 November. Students need to be at school early as the **bus departs at 8:00am sharp** and will return at approximately 5:00pm. This excursion is heavily subsidised by the school and the P&C to ensure all students have the opportunity to attend.

Regular school attendance is extremely important for your child to keep up with the learning taking place in their class. It has been a difficult couple of years but things are now on a more 'normal' path. If your child needs to be absent from school you must contact the teacher or the school by dojo message, note or phone to register the reason for the absence. Students are required to attend at least 90% of the time which means no more than 5 days away per term. Thank you for your support.

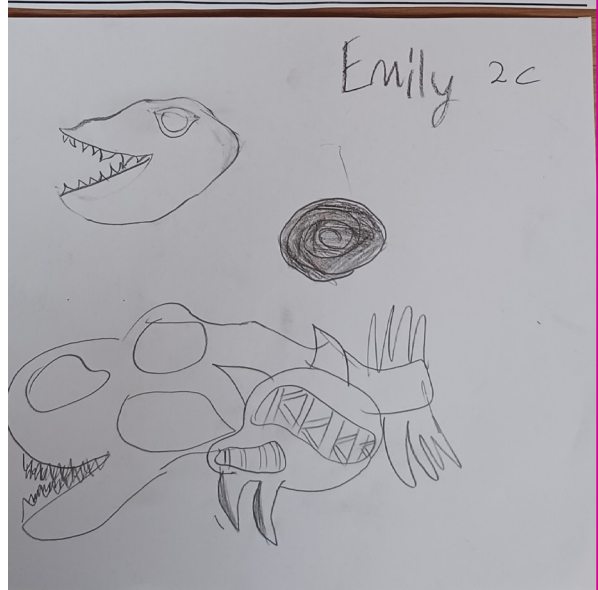
From the library desk

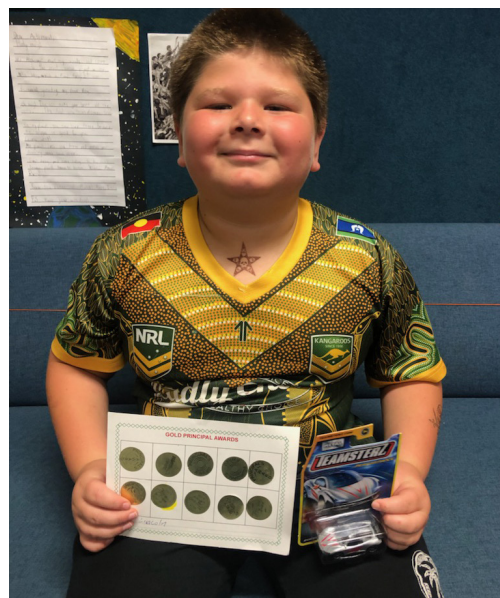
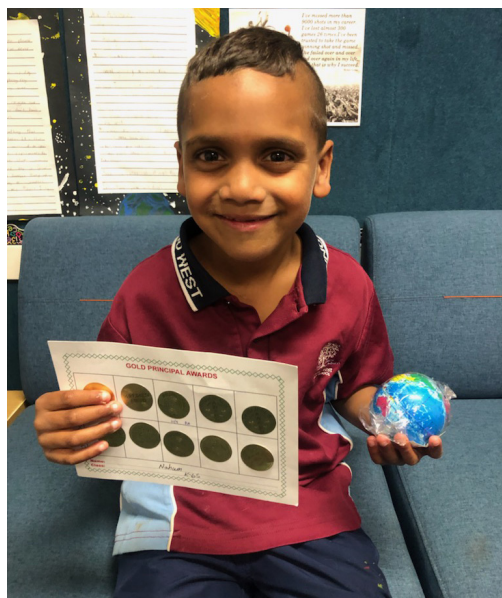
