

'World Kindness Day is celebrated around the world on November 13. **What exactly is 'kindness'?** It is the quality of being friendly, generous and considerate.


It is what we all hope to be and it is what we hope our students to be. Here are a few suggestions for how we can be especially kind to others this week:


- Hold the door open for someone.

- Be nice to your teacher by showing respect and doing your work.


The library has many stories that have kindness as the main theme. We also have stories that place characters in situations where they show kindness towards others, often in difficult situations.


