Check-in assessment for Year 6

Dear Parents and Carers,

Students in Years 6 will participate in a Reading, Numeracy and Writing Check-in assessment.

The Check-in assessment is a NSW Department of Education online reading and numeracy assessment available to support schools to assess and monitor student learning.

The Check-in assessments can supplement existing school practices to identify how students are performing in literacy and numeracy and to help teachers tailor their teaching more specifically to student needs.

- The assessment for **Reading and Numeracy** is scheduled for Year 6 on;
 - Tuesday 5th September, 2023 (Term 3 – Week 8)
- The assessment for **Writing** is scheduled for Year 6 on;
 - Tuesday 19th September, 2023 (Term 3 – Week 10)

Students will be completing the assessments online during the morning sessions at school.
