Principal Report

It has been a busy term with many activities and projects undertaken.

Students have been engaged in dance groups, athletics, performance shows, Stewart House, Aboriginal Education Group STEM camp and Interest Groups have been introduced; teachers run interest groups of around 8 children for 2 3 week blocks on a Wednesday afternoon. All activities have been extremely successful.

NAPLAN results went home to families of Year 3 and Year 5 students today and school result tables should be published very soon. This data is used to inform our school teaching and learning programs. This information also goes into our Annual School Report.

The placement of concrete areas for handball courts and Stage 3 eating area are waiting for tables to be bolted on, this should happen soon. The curriculum shed is just about complete and will house new maths and science equipment boxes for class borrowing.

We have been successful with the Queens Jubilee Project thanks to the P&C and have received \$20000 to create garden areas in the school. There will be a morning or afternoon tea for the planting of this project early in term 1 and families will be invited to come and plant a tree with their children.

Our school is engaged in a project with all Casino Schools to gauge the needs of the Casino community through the eyes of our students and their families. We will be having a student forum on Monday 5 Sept with students who have returned their permission slips.

Year 3/4 and year 5/6 students have received information about their class excursions and everyone is very excited. Year 5/6 are going to Sea World, staying overnight and then to Australia Zoo the following day. Years 3 and 4 are heading for a long day excursion to Currumbin Sanctuary. Thank you to the P&C for supporting the cost of these excursions to make them cheaper for all families.

Our proposed Art Show is gathering momentum with sponsors and applicants alike. There will be prizes and lucky door draws for those attending. Details to be finalised very soon.
